

ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Subsequently, Science courses were introduced at the PU level in 1963 and at the degree level in 1965. In 1972, the Government of Karnataka extended the duration of the PU courses by one year, and the new two-year PU course remained composited with the degree course at Poornaprajna College until 2001.

COURSES OFFERED

- 1. The college will reopen for new admissions during May and June of every year to admit fresh students to the following courses of Pre-University Course (P.U.C).
- 2. To be eligible for admission to the first-year PU course, candidates must have passed a recognized School Leaving Certificate examination such as SSLC or an equivalent exam.
- 3. Candidates have to choose subjects under Part I and Part II.
 - Part I: Candidates can choose any one of the following language combinations: a) English and Kannada b) English and Hindi
 - c) English and Sanskrit
 - Part II: Candidates can choose any one of the following subject combinations: a) Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & Biology [PCMB] b) Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & Statistics [PCMS] c) Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & Computer Science [PCMCs] d) Business Studies, Accountancy, Statistics & Economics [BASE] e) Business Studies, Accountancy, Statistics & Basic Maths

[BASM] f) Business Studies, Accountancy, Statistics & Computer Science [BASCs]

Note: Each of the above subject combinations is a two-year program that leads to a Pre-University Certificate (PUC). The PUC is a recognized qualification for admission to undergraduate courses in India.

ADMISSION

a) Procedure for applying for Admission to I PUC:

- 1. Candidates can obtain the application form and prospectus from the college office by paying Rs.200/-
- Completed application forms should be submitted at the college office within a week from the announcement of Karnataka SSLC
 results, along with a fee of Rs.20/-. Students from CBSE, ICSE, or other equivalent boards can submit their applications while
 awaiting results.
- 3. Incomplete or incorrect applications will not be considered.
- b) Selection of candidates: Candidates will be selected based on merit and the government policy for unaided colleges.

c) Regarding Admission:

- 1. Selected candidates will be informed of the date and time of admission via phone.
- 2. Candidates must take admission on the specified date and time.
- 3. If the given date is inconvenient, candidates can meet with the Principal and reschedule for another convenient date.
- 4. Failure to follow either of the above-mentioned steps will result in cancellation of admission.

d) At the time of Admission:

- 1. Candidates must be accompanied by their father/mother/guardian.
- 2. Complete fees must be paid at the time of admission.
- 3. Candidates must provide the original Transfer Certificate (TC) and Conduct Certificate.
- 4. Candidates must provide the original SSLC Mark Card along with a photocopy (two photocopies in case of non-Karnataka SSLC).
- 5. Candidates must provide a copy of the Hall Ticket for the SSLC or equivalent examination.
- e) Conditions of Admission: All admissions are provisional and subject to approval by the PU Education Department in Bengaluru.

f) Fee structure and Regulations:

- 1. The first-year fees must be paid soon after the admission process is completed.
- 2. The fees paid are non-refundable under any circumstance.

IMPORTANT:

- 1. If a student intends to apply for more than one combination, they have to apply separately for those combinations.
- 2. Students seeking admission under the reservation quota must attach a photocopy of the relevant caste certificate to their application form. The caste certificate cannot be submitted later and must be attached to the application itself. The original caste certificate should be produced at the time of admission, which will be returned immediately after verification.
